Training towards the first CIDESCO examination cannot commence until CIDESCO has given written approval for probationary training. Only after probationary training has been granted but not less than a full school year of probationary status can the first CIDESCO examination be conducted. A school must stay on probationary training until they have successfully passed their first examination. A successful examination is deemed successful if the school receives Satisfactory and above in both the theory and the practical examinations. 70% or higher is considered Satisfactory.
